ANNOUNCING Registration opens June 27 - Sept 30, 2019 for the last scheduled CNA Specialty Certification Exam in Rehabilitation Nursing in November 2019. Remember, if you write in November you will play a vital part in helping to save our certification exam. You will also be able to keep your registration for your entire nursing career and beyond. Please see the fact sheet for details! Our numbers are in! So far in 2019 we have 4 exam writers, 6 already renewed by CL hours, and 51 Certified nurse's eligible to renew this year (by Nov 1, 2019).
